SIR,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter, dated 10th December, 1909, submitting a copy of the **First Book of Music**, and to state, in reply, as follows.

2. The question of introducing the instruction of music into the first grade Training Schools of this Province is at present under the consideration of Government, ^{whose} ~~whose~~ sanction on the subject is awaited by this office. In the meantime your book was forwarded for opinion as to its suitability, to some of the Departmental officers in the Province, having some knowledge of the subject, and a copy of the reply of one of them, Babu S.P.D. Shaw, is forwarded herewith for your information, with the intimation that you may exercise your own discretion as to ~~what~~ action you should take, in anticipation of the introduction of the new training school curriculum.
